

A wells water quality should be tested regularly. If coliform or E.coli are repeatedly being detected then the source of bacterial contamination should be identified and removed whenever possible. Otherwise the well will continue to be vulnerable to contamination

Here are some potential causes for Contamination

- Is there manure or compost piles, septic disposal field, or hazardous materials storage near or around well?
- Does the ground slope towards the well and allow surface water or ponding of water around the well?
- Is the well cap missing, cracked or damaged?
- Does the well casing stick up less than 12 inches from the ground surface or the floor of the house?
- Is there an unfilled space or gap between the well casing and the ground around the well?
- Is the will finished below grade?
- Are there any noticeable cracks in the surface seal around the well casing?
